

## **Possible Interventions If the Student Wants to Escape from Peers:**

1. Student can earn time to visit the principal for a friendly visit
2. Substitute any other adult in the sentence above (SRO, Librarian, etc.)
3. Student can earn privilege to create their own little office space in the room that is visually away from other students.
4. Student can earn privilege of staying in at recess to hang out for fun.
5. Student can earn privilege of staying after school to hang out. The reason for this is sometimes to avoid peers on the bus ride home and if parent agrees to come pick them up, this can be a reward one day a week
6. Time alone in the library
7. Earn time to stay in at recess
8. Create own office space in classroom
