Recommended TRIM Timeline

- July 1** Date of certification. Property Appraiser certifies to the school district the taxable value of its Jackson County jurisdiction. (Form DR420S) – TRIM DAY 1 (Thursday)
- July 16** Tentative date for Department of Education millage certification – TRIM DAY 16 (Friday)
- July 20** Superintendent submits budget to school board for approval to advertise – TRIM DAY 20 (Tuesday)
REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING DATE (Budget workshop to precede meeting)
- July 23** The school district will advertise its intent to adopt the tentative millage rates and budget per TRIM requirements (*Jackson County Floridian*) – TRIM DAY 23 (Friday)
- July 27** The school district will hold a public hearing on the tentative millage rates and budget – TRIM DAY 27 (Tuesday)
- Hearing must be held after 5:00 pm (5:01 pm).
 - Should announce publicly the percent, if any, by which the millage rates exceed the rolled-back rate.
- Special meeting follows public hearing.
- Tentative **millage** must be adopted first by resolution.
 - Tentative **budget** must be adopted second by resolution.
- SPECIAL SCHOOL BOARD MEETING DATE**
- July 29** Submittal of completed Form DR 420S to Property Appraiser indicating:
- (a) Prior year millage rate.
 - (b) Current year proposed millage rate.
 - (c) Current year rolled-back rate.
 - (d) The date, time, and meeting place of the final budget hearing.
- TRIM DAY 39 (Thursday)
- August 24** Property Appraiser will mail (or will have mailed) the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes – TRIM DAY 55 (Tuesday)
- Sept 16** The school district will hold a public hearing on the final millage rates and budget – TRIM DAY 78 (Thursday)
- Hearing must be held after 5:00 pm (5:01 pm).
 - School district will amend the tentatively adopted millage rates and budget, if needed, and announce publicly the percent, if any, by which the recomputed millage rates exceed the rolled-back rate.
- Special meeting follows public hearing.
- Final **millage** must be adopted first by resolution.
 - Final **budget** must be adopted second by resolution.
- REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD WORKSHOP DATE**
- Sept 17*** Resolution adopting final millage rate will be forwarded to the Property Appraiser and Tax Collector – TRIM DAY 79 (Friday)

***WITHIN 3 DAYS** after receipt of Certification of Final Taxable Value (Form DR 422) the school district certifies final millage to the Property Appraiser and Tax Collector.

WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FINAL HEARING the school district will certify compliance (Form DR 487) with the provisions of Florida Statutes related to TRIM compliance, Florida Department of Revenue.
