

**JCSB Procedures for handling ½ Credit Averaging**  
(effective July 2009)

½ Credit Averaging Rule—

For a year-long course, the student fails one semester and passes the other and the averaging of the 2 semester grades results in a passing grade...

Schools need to collect the resulting passing average (“yearly” average)

In Academic History,

BOTH semester courses (the failed semester AND the passed semester) will be given an “X” flag

(to exclude them from GPA and Bright Futures calculations)

A new record will be entered which has the Yearly averaged grade,

an External Term = “3” (to indicate a year-long course),

an “I” flag (to include in GPA and Bright Futures calculations), and

a “C” flag (to indicate this record is a result of ½ credit averaging)
